What makes Phil Cartwright smile? "I enjoy the solitude when I come out and walk the trails (at Blatchley Nature Study Club). We live three miles away so I come here a lot in the evening after work ... It's amazing to think you're right in the middle of Noblesville and all of this suburban activity and can enjoy this nature. I like it when I can see the owls. We have a fox den on the property that sometimes we'll see the fox ... and sometimes will see kits but not this year so far. And I like the people, who have similar nature inclinations," said the 69-year-old Noblesville resident. He was found leading Blatchley's cleanup day on Saturday in preparation for the 100th anniversary Spring Wildflower Walk and Centennial Celebration with guided wildflower walks 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays, April 16 and 30, at Blatchley Nature Study Club, 125 Boulder Drive, in Noblesville. He joined the club 16 years ago when he and his wife, Sherry, moved to the area. His wife, Sherry, is involved with the club also, "but not when it's cold weather and wintery outside," he said during the mid 30s F cleanup day. She's also a member of North Harbor Garden Club and does bits of work with the Blatchley club. Both are Master Gardeners. Both are outdoor people and do a lot of hiking. "We're really into butterflies. We have a 2,500-square-foot prairie in our backyard. We raise butterfly chrysalis." They belonged to a similar club when they lived in Mishawaka, Wis. So when they moved here, they looked for a nature club to join. "We happened to wander by the same day they were having their wildflower walk," Cartwright said. He looks forward to the upcoming wildflower walks this month, hoping to meet new folks who were just like them, looking for a new place to venture.







followed the signs down and introduced ourselves and became members at the next meeting.'

Cartwright loves the 15-acre property. "It is hidden back here. It's a very nice property. It's a surprise. Nobody knows it's here."

The weather was in the mid 30s on Saturday, kind of cold for a cleanup day. "It is, but our purpose ... for the cleanup day early in spring is to get ready for the two wildflower walks that we host at the end of the month," he said. "We like all of our trails and everything to be in good shape before the public comes out."

Guided wildflower walks are scheduled for 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on two

for use as a sanctuary and on which to build a clubhouse on March 8, 1963. The Clubhouse (built with a generous monetary gift from Eli Lilly family, who were members) and the sanctuary was dedicated on July 18, 1965. A step inside the clubhouse today, Cartwright said, "You'll find it hasn't changed."

Each spring, the club leads Wildflower Walks, inviting the community to attend. Spring Wildflower Walk and Centennial Celebration in April.

Cartwright is in charge of maintenance at the Blatchley clubhouse and the sanctuary and is a Blatchley board member.

"What we're doing is cleaning off the trails. any limbs that have fallen off in the wind lately so there's no trip hazards. We're improving some areas that have been eroded by filling them in. We're replacing some boards on our bridges and steps that have also tended to rot away a little bit. We're placing wildflower signs as we can tell where they're going to be. Because of the cold weather, it's going to be sort of a last-minute thing next Saturday morning prior to the

walk," he said. What's the weather forecast? "It's going

to be perfect weather (actually partly cloudy and highs in the mid 50s, according to the weather forecast). We're hoping for no rain," Cartwright said.

"All of the grounds' early-spring ephemerals are out, (like) white salt-and-pepper flowers, really small flowers, black-and-white flecked, one of the very first that comes out," he said.

"Folks will see Bloodroot (one of the first wildflowers to open its bright white flowers). It'll be a little too early for the Jack-in-the-pulpits at that time; that'll probably be at the end of the month. We see some spring anemone. It's a little too early, until the next time, to see the shooting stars, which are on the bluff that overlooks the (White) river."

The Club traditionally offered a single wildflower walk in the middle of the month. We've noticed over the years, a lot of times we'll get wet and cold weather early, so we added a second one (walk)," Cartwright said.

Being this year's 100th anniversary of the club, members wanted there to be two wildflower walks so there will be more available open times for the public to come out

and enjoy the grounds. Noblesville East Middle School science teacher and president of the club Rick Towle had a chainsaw in hand as he headed for an unpaved trail with fellow club member Bill St. Dennis, to cut a fallen tree, a safety hazard, along the trail.

"We had a lot of storm damage ... All of these trees have snapped off, broken down, on the far side, are in the way, some visually in the way," he said, walking the trail toward a wooden staircase built a year ago to help hikers avoid mud. Saturday's volunteers would do cleanup until about noon, said Towle, who had been out working on the club property a couple of days prior during his spring break.

Blatchley property has iust more than a mile of unpaved trails. The wildflower walks are usually a small loop and cover "a much more floral walk."

He pointed to the area next to the wooden stairway. "We're going to put a deck out here and a bench," Towle said, drawing attention to a long-distance view, "across the way," of a fox den with a family of foxes that come out and play.

Towle was born and

raised in central Massachusetts, moved to Indiana and graduated from North Central High School in 1975, University of Evansville in 1979 and graduate school at Purdue University in 1985.

He was introduced to the club back in 2004-05 by Blatchley member, John Duncan, one of the parents who traveled with NEMS to the Amazon Rainforest. "Attended a couple of Blatchley meetings, liked what I saw, and joined up shortly after," he said. "The like-mindedness of the members -- enjoying and preserving and conversing about nature -- really appealed to me. The rest, as they say, is history."

Towle is looking forward to the 2022 Centennial Celebration. He said, "I am humbled by the opportunity to lead our club of nature enthusiasts into the next 100-year chapter of our esteemed organization."

years of experience in researching genealogy and

local history. When Nancy began working in the indiana Room in 1992, it occupied just a small part of the library's second floor. Back then, a mere two tables were provided for patrons' use, the book shelves only contained reference books that didn't circulate and shock! — there were no computers.

Today, the Indiana Room covers a considerably larger area and houses a treasure trove of genealogical and historical information on its shelves and in its databases. Much of that is a result of Nancy's efforts.

Take, for example, one of my most frequently used sources, the vertical files. When Nancy started working in the IR, there were only eight file cabinets for Hamilton County subjects,

Indiana subjects AND family histories. Now, there are eight file cabinets devoted to Hamilton County alone.

(In case you don't know what a vertical file is, it's the place to find valuable information too small or too fragile to be shelved, e.g. newspaper clippings, pamphlets, etc.)

Widely acknowledged as a local authority on genealogical research (in 2013 she was appointed THE Hamilton County Genealogist by the Indiana Genealogical Society,) Nancy has not only presented genealogy workshops and programs at the library, she's also given presentations to various outside genealogical organizations.

Under her guidance, the IR has become a resource center for people all over the country seeking to fill gaps in their family

trees. She even fielded one research request from Germany!

She's equally knowledgeable about local history

Whenever I've been pressed for time or couldn't make it to the IR to dig up some detail for this column in person, I've always known I could count on Nancy to come up with what I needed.

I'm not the only writer she's helped. You'll find her assistance acknowledged in such non-fiction books as Scott Beekman's "William Dudley Pelley: A Life in Right-Wing Extremism and the Occult" and Wendell Trogdon's "America's Stringtowns: Forgotten Communities."

She's also provided information for out-of-state fiction authors researching Noblesville as a historical setting for their books and has even produced a couple

of books on local history herself — a pictorial history of Noblesville she co-authored with Carol Ann Schweikert (now Johnson) and "A Brief History of Noblesville" which she co-authored with me.

Of all her library accomplishments, however, the one of which she's most proud is the acquisition of a Library Services and Technology Act grant that's allowed the IR to undertake various digitization projects.

Thanks to Nancy, you can now use your computer to view items such as the Noblesville Mayor Docket books and Dr. Earl Brooks 1923 Hamilton County Centennial photos on the Indiana State Library's Indiana Memory website.

You can also explore city directories and Evans-Godby-Trout Funeral Home records at ancestry. com, and local historical newspapers at Newspapers.com.

And those are just a sample of the Indiana Room's ongoing digitization projects.

Best of wishes on your retirement, Nancy! I know you'll be missed by a LOT of library patrons.
