Besides winning Junior Sheep Showman, she won third overall for Swine Junior Division and Champion Oxford Ewe and Reserve Champion Shropshire. She is the daughter of Ben and Audrey Lehman. Ben Lehman was a 10-year Hamilton County 4-H'er and winner of the 2004 Supreme Snowmanship. She hopes to follow in his footsteps someday. Strange Fads **And Other** Weirdness



DUNN From Time to Thyme

I didn't have anything in particular planned for this week, so I decided to take the opportunity to dig into my files and pull out some of the odd little items I've run across

in the old newspapers, things that caught my eye, but didn't contain enough details to fill an entire column on their own.

As I wrote, I suddenly realized everything I'd gathered was fitting into one of two categories — either strange fads, or odd lost and found items.

I'm not sure what that says about my subconscious mind. I just found these bits humorous and I figured we could use a good laugh (or at least a good chuckle.)

The fads.

The June 1, 1883 Republican Ledger noted that ladies had begun embroidering their handkerchiefs with various "mottoes suitable for the mood of the day." The examples provided were: "I am cross; don't speak to me," "What a lovely day," and "I don't care for compa-

Not content to let women have all the fun, the newspaper encouraged men to do the same and suggested some more manly phrases for their handkerchiefs: "I will pay you next week," "Lend me a quarter," "Don't care if I do," and

That last one puzzled me, so I looked "Damfino" up and discovered it wasn't nearly as mysterious or exotic as it appears at first glance. (If you say it fast and pronounce the "fi" as "fie," it should make sense.)

The September 27, 1889 Noblesville Democrat observed that peanut socials were currently all the rage in the surrounding area and expressed surprise that no Noblesville church had thrown one yet.

The newspaper explained that, contrary to what you might think, a peanut social didn't consist solely of "an entire bill of fare of this peculiarly indigestible edible." Rather it included "almost anything the committees can think of, from toast and coffee to a full-sized European-plan restaurant supper."

Invitations to these shindigs were written or printed, and slid between halves of a peanut shell. The halves were then tied back together with fancy ribbons, "forming odd souvenirs."

(That must have been some VERY tiny writing.) The August 22, 1905 Hamilton County Ledger announced

ORDINANCE NO. CC 08-02-2023.A AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HAMILTON COUNTY CODE 6-9-18-3 WHEREAS, Hamilton County, pursuant to Indiana Code 6-9-18 et al.,

previously adopted a 5% innkeeper's tax as set forth in Section 6-9-18-3 of the Hamilton County Code; and,

WHEREAS, the General Assembly passed H.E.A 1454, and the Governor gigned the same into law, which adds Indiana Code 6-9-56 to the Indiana Code effective as of July 1, 2023;and
WHEREAS, Indiana Code 6-9-56 authorizes the fiscal body of Hamilton

County to increase in the innkeepers tax rate for Hamilton County to a tax not to exceed the rate of 8% on the gross retail income derived from lodging income only and is in addition to the state gross retail tax imposed under Indiana Code WHEREAS, Indiana Code 6-9-56 authorizes the county fiscal body of Hamilton County to adopt an ordinance that would require the tax to be paid

monthly to the county treasurer with said tax funds being allocated to separate specific funds, namely the current convention, visitor and tourism promotion fund "tourism promotion fund"), and also a new tourism capital fund"; and WHEREAS, Indiana Code 6-9-56 specifically requires the creation of a

commission by the county executive to promote the development and growth of the convention, visitor and tourism in the Hamilton County and for purposes of ransfers of money from the tourism promotion fund and the tourism capital fund; and WHEREAS, Hamilton County previously created the Hamilton County

Convention. Visitor and Tourism Commission in accordance with Indiana Code 6-9-18-

IT IS THEREBY ORDAINED by the Hamilton County Council that on 6-9-18-3 of the Hamilton County Code is amended as follows:

(a) A tax shall be levied on every entity, person, corporation, or other business combination engaged in the business of renting or furnishing, for periods pased upon a daily basis or multiples thereof, any room, lodging, or tourist cabin

(b) The tax does not apply to gross income received in a transaction in which a person rents:

(1) Lodgings in a college or university residence hall; A room, lodging, or accommodations based upon a month-

An apartment, or residence, which is the person's (3) unent, primary residence on a tenancy of less than a month-to-month basis.
(c) The tax shall be levied at the rate of eight percent (8%) on the gross retail income derived from lodging income only and is in addition to the state gross retail tax imposed under IC 6-2.5.

(d) The tax shall be paid monthly to the county treasurer, which shall be paid to the county treasurer not more than twenty (20) days after the end of the nonth the tax is collected.

(e) The county treasurer shall establish the following funds: (1) A Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Promotion Fund; and (2) a Tourism Capital Fund. The county treasurer shall deposit tax funds collected as follows:

 Tax received in the treasurer's collection of innkeepers tax funds that is not more than five percent (5%) of the funds collected shall be deposited into Convention, Visitor and Tourism Promotion Fund; and

Tax received it in the treasurer's collection of innkeepers ax funds that exceeds five percent (5%) of the funds collected shall be deposited in the Tourism Capital fund.

(f) The Hamilton County Convention, Visitor and Tourism Commission ("Commission") is hereby duly authorized to transfer money from the Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Promotion Fund and Tourism Capital Fund in accordance with this ordinance and Indiana Code 6-9-56 (g) The county auditor shall issue a warrant directing the county treasurer to transfer money from the Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Promotion Fund and

Tourism Capital Fund to the Commission's treasurer if the Commission submits a written request for the transfer. (h) Money in the Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Promotion Fund or money transferred from such a fund to the Commission may only be expended to promote and encourage conventions, visitors, and tourism within Hamilton County, Expenditures from the Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Promotion Fund may include expenditures for advertising, promotional activities, trade shows, special events, and recreation. The Commission may transfer money in he Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Promotion Fund to any Indiana nonprofit corporation for the purpose of promotion and encouragement in the county of conventions, trade shows, visitors, or special events. The Commission may transfer money under this section only after approving the transfer. The Commission may transfer money under this subsection on a monthly basis or at

mother frequency as determined by the Commission. (i) Money in the Tourism Capital Fund, or money transferred from such fund to the Commission, may only be expended on infrastructure projects that mprove or benefit the tourism

economy. Expenditures from the Tourism Capital Fund may include acquisition, construction, alteration, improvements, or installation costs of any existing tangible property or tangible property that is to be constructed. Expenditures may include fees for professional services such as architectural,

building consulting or planning, and infrastructure feasibility.

(i) The Commission must approve any transfer of money from the Tourism Capital Fund and may transfer money from the Tourism Capital Fund to support capital projects in the county that promote long term tourism, convention, or recreation projects proposed by any of the following:

(I) The county government;

(2) A city government;

(3) A separate body corporate and politic in Hamilton County; or (4) Any Indiana nonprofit corporation in Hamilton County. The Commission may transfer money under this subsection on a monthly

basis or at another frequency as determined by the Commission.

(k) The Commission may also review and approve proposals submitted

by applicants that seek money from the tourism capital fund with the purpose and view of enhancing or providing support for capital projects that promote long term tourism, convention, or other economic development related to recreation Funding available under this subsection shall be made available on an annual basis. In determining whether to provide funding to a particular capital project under this subsection, the commission may use the following factors as a guide for capital project funding:

(1) The proposed capital project is believed to be economically capital project is believed to be economy and is

sound to the Hamilton County tourism, convention, or recreation economy and is also believed to be beneficial to:

(A) the general population of Hamilton County; or(B) a particular location in Hamilton County.

(2) The proposed capital project provides for reasonably dequate public assembly, gathering, or entertainment space and is integrally related to enhancing the tourism, convention, or recreation opportunities in Hamilton County or a particular location in Hamilton County

The Commission makes a reasonable effort to assess whether a proposed capital project aligns with the purpose of the Commission and has a direct, indirect, or supportive relationship to the mission and promotional efforts of the commission as established and funded by the convention, visitor, and tourism promotion fund. A capital project proposed by an applicant that does not meet at least

one (1) of the criteria set forth in this subsection will not be funded, and any remaining funds collected revert to the tourism capital fund for distribution by the Commission on projects within Hamilton County. An applicant that receives a grant of money from the tourism capital fund under subsection must agree to provide to the Commission proof of project completion, including proof that the project was completed through the use of the grant money; and may be subject to

annual financial reporting and audit.
(I) All money coming into possession of the Commission shall be deposited, held, secured, invested, and paid in accordance with statutes relating to the handling of public funds. The handling and expenditure of money coming into possession of the Commission is subject to audit and supervision by the state

Linden Tree in Carmel, which has a more "contemporary feel," she said.

As far as parking, there isn't a two-hour limit on the street out front or to the side. Plus, there are five labeled Linden Tree parking spaces across the street in the former motorbank lot, which Peck also owns.

Upon opening at the new location, on the first day, Anderson said, "We had a lot of people who knew when we were opening and were here the first day. We had a great response.

At the end of July, Anderson opened an amenities bar, with freshly brewed coffee and cold drinks for customers to enjoy while shopping.

Anderson is the fourth owner of The Linden Tree.

Carol Ryan opened the store 38 years ago and operated the store about 15 years. "She was here for our grand opening party. She still shops with us. It's so cool.. I love that she shops with us. I feel honored," Anderson said.

Linden Petit was the second owner and operated the store for about seven years. Then Debbi Smith was the third owner, who was closing the store in 2008. Smith had a full-time job and wasn't in the store all of the time.

"I walked in there to shop, and it was closing," Anderson recalled. "So I called my husband, and he came over. We made an offer to buy it. I didn't have a clue what I was doing," Anderson said.

She had never been in sales or owned a business. "I'm a high school math teacher," said Anderson, who also worked in real estate for many years, and then part time in an office after she had kids. "I had no retail experience -- zero," she said.

Being that she would be required to buy all of the inventory, before they bought the business, she wanted to make sure that the store would remain in the same space, keep the Linden Tree name and be open in October, November and December of that year. "I know enough about shopping and shopping trends that you have to be open at Christmas time.'

She said, "We've been growing since then." While the Linden Tree

used to be known mainly as a gift shop, she said, "Gifts just weren't cutting

She said, "You couldn't even stay in business if you didn't keep evolving. And we had to add clothing. That was kind of a trend, and I think we caught on kind of early ... that's what has made us grow bigger."

That was about 10 years ago.

Anderson said, "I sell clothing for people, probably my age, where we want to be a little trendy, but we want to be appropriate for our ages." She sells a lot of Tribal (Fashion) and Fenini, Shalea, Cut Loose and Shawna brands. Her customers include "a lot of the people who have not such a small waist anymore, but we still want to be cool."

She's also adding Consuela, a handbag line that Linden Tree carries in Carmel; and also Voluspa candles this fall and a new brand of retro cocktail serveware.

Anderson, who's been going "to market" for 14 years, traveled to Atlanta, Ga., in July and shopped and stocked up on new items for the shop.

Her former store on Logan Street on the Courthouse Square moved after a new landlord had other plans for the space. The store, which was closed for about five days in June, reopened on June 20.

Moving to a new location comes in the middle of her life plans.

Anderson is 62. "I thought I was going to retire when I was 65, but I had to sign a five-year lease," she said.

While she doesn't have as much space, including storage, as the former location, she's quickly acclimating to the new digs. And from her new building's rooftop, she enjoys the outdoor seating and picturesque view of the City.

She said, "I'm hoping my store has value. I'm hoping I can sell (when she's ready for retirement) to someone who will take it to the next level."

Anderson was born in Fort Wayne and grew up in Kokomo and graduated from Taylor High School in Howard County. She earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics education at Ball State University and taught school for three years. She has been married 24 years to Jim Anderson. "He worked his butt off in here getting my store open. He built the counter, he did so much for me. I was lucky to have a handy person." She has three children, ages 32, 35 and 37, and grandchildren ages 8, 2 and 4 months.

She is also thankful for her employees, especially her sister, Sherri Newkirk, a longtime employee who's been with her since the store opened.

The Linden Tree participates in Noblesville Main Street merchant events, and Anderson encourages folks to stop in during the next event, the Chocolate Trail on First Friday, on Sept. 1.

Anderson said, "We need people to find us and remember that we're here."

latest thing to hit surrounding cities and was bound to pop up in Noblesville soon.

According to the newspaper, "dainty maidens" were decorating their "pretty little toes" with ribbons and rings, and comparing their "tootsies" to decide who had the "prettiest little foot."

Readers were informed that they shouldn't be surprised if, in the near future, they received an invitation that included a request that read something like" come and bring your feet.'

And now, the Lost and Found Department . . .

The Mar. 20, 1885 Republican Ledger reported that someone had recently raided "Dock" (Doc) Burrough's poultry house and had made off with a dozen or so of Burrough's best hens. In the process, the thief left behind a size 12 overshoe.

The Ledger noted that the offender could "have the same by calling and

proving property." I couldn't find a followup story about the overshoe being claimed. (Gee, what a surprise.)

A few months later, the July 3, 1885 Republican Ledger announced that a set of upper teeth had been found on the pike near the Heady schoolhouse. (The "pike" would be Allisonville Road. The Heady schoolhouse was located at 126th Street and Allisonville Road, overlooking Heady Hollow.)

The newspaper relayed the information that the owner of the teeth could claim their lost choppers "by calling on Mrs. Frasier at No. 1 gate on Greenfield pike.

I'm still trying to figure out how somebody could lose their teeth out on the road and not know what became of them.






